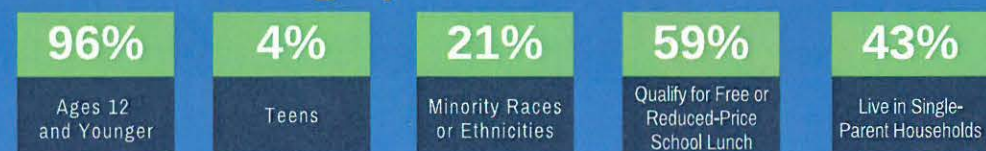
The Need in Our State

We provide homework help and tutoring programs that help our Members develop good study habits. We incorporate high-yield learning activities to make learning fun!



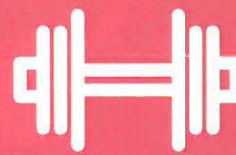

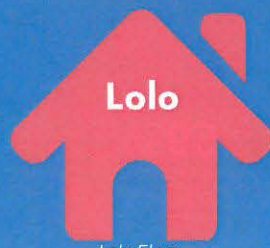

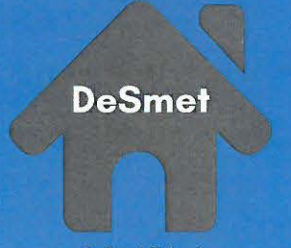
